Welcome back from what we hope was a fun & relaxing summer for you and your family. As we transition out of summer to the fall, Rowland Unified looks forward to providing another exciting school year for our students.

As we begin our 2016-2017 school year, one of the newest programs that will be implemented in the elementary curriculum is the music expansion program. This expansion allows <u>ALL</u> RUSD students (grades 1-6) to participate in different musical experiences.

When students enter 4th grade, they will have a choice of continuing to learn more about General Music with a recorder and choir emphasis **OR** learn to play a string instrument. When students enter 5th & 6th grade, they will have the choice to participate in either General Music (Choir), Strings, or Band class. The music expansion program offers the flexibility for students to choose what music path best suits their learning style and interests and provides them with a dedicated weekly, 50 minute music class of their choosing.
